The North-West Pacific Action Plan, which is not legally binding, was adopted in 1994 and covers the marine environment and coastal zones of NOWPAP member states from about 121°E to 143°E longitude, and from approximately 52°N to 33°N latitude, without prejudice to the sovereign right of any State.
